Hello board members and citizens. In the month of December the fire department and first responders had a total combined call volume of 13 calls for service.

The fire fighters and medical first responders completed their annual physicals per OSHA requirements and are good for another year.

Year end summary:

In total for 2024, the fire department responded to 103 calls for service while the first responders responded to 108 calls for service totaling 211 calls for the year. This was slightly above our average for

190 calls. **A couple other highlights:** Our command/rehab trailer was put into service which is designed to fill air packs, carry our water rescue equipment, and rehab emergency responders with a warm place in the winter and cool place in the summer. We also were able to purchase our new truck #1710, this has the capability to fight fires with its 1500 GPM pump plus carry our extrication equipment.
